- The June goods and services deficit (\$75.7 billion) was the highest on record.
  - \* The June goods deficit (\$93.2 billion) was the highest on record.
- June exports of goods and services (\$207.7 billion) were the highest since December 2019 (\$209.9 billion).
  - \* June exports of goods (\$145.9 billion) were the highest on record.
- June imports of goods and services (\$283.4 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June imports of goods (\$239.1 billion) were the highest on record.

## Goods (Census Basis, seasonally adjusted)

### Balance

\* The June goods deficit (\$92.1 billion) was the highest on record.

#### **Exports**

- \* June exports of goods (\$145.3 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June exports of consumer goods (\$18.0 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June exports of industrial supplies and materials (\$53.5 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June exports of petroleum (\$17.8 billion) were the highest on record.

#### Imports

- \* June imports of goods (\$237.4 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June imports of industrial supplies and materials (\$56.9 billion) were the highest since April 2014 (\$58.1 billion).
- \* June imports of foods, feeds, and beverages (\$16.0 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June real dollar imports of foods, feeds, and beverages (\$14.1 billion) were the highest on record.

## Country and Other Highlights (Census Basis, not seasonally adjusted)

#### Balance

\* The June deficit with Taiwan (\$3.5 billion) was the highest on record.

#### Exports

\* June exports to Brazil (\$4.2 billion) were the highest since August 2013 (\$4.2 billion).

## **Imports**

- June imports from Taiwan (\$6.6 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June imports from South Korea (\$8.5 billion) were the highest on record.
- \* June imports from Canada (\$32.1 billion) were the highest since July 2008 (\$32.2 billion).
